We'll be making LEGO creations while we chat with friends at this drop-in program.

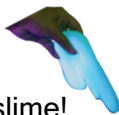


Sensory Station

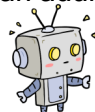
Come check out a range of sensory bins and activities at this drop-in. This program is open to all ages, but some activities may not be appropriate for children prone to mouthing/teething.

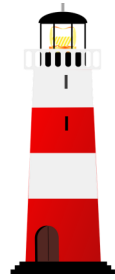
