09.10.2025 - The weather is changing and so are we!

We are still on schedule to move to our new circulation system on October 22, 2025. We will be putting out more information as the time gets closer. Please note, due to staff training on the new system, at this time we are planning to open at noon for the week of September 29 through October 4th. There are too many features in the new system to cover here, but we'll all be able to help you navigate when the time comes!

Speaking of new...Hoopla has taken off far beyond expectations - but it is also a very expensive service, and we would like to preserve it. Many of you may have heard some other local libraries eliminating Hoopla entirely because of the costs associated. While we are not at that point, we are going to have to move to restricting patrons to 4 checkouts per month in order to maintain the service in our budget. The current limit of 6 checkouts per patron per month will end October 1, 2025.

Just a quick reminder, if you are looking to reserve a room at the library, please do so as soon as you can confirm your dates/times. We will work to accommodate as much as we can, but reservations are on a first come, first served basis. And please bear in mind our capacity limits which are governed by the fire code.
