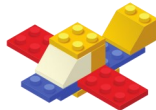
Beginning 9/20, Join Miss Karly with your toddlers and children for stories, STEM activities, crafts, songs, and more!

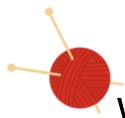

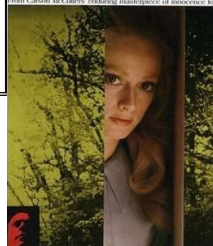

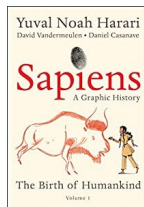
When deaf-mute Singer moves to a new town to be near his hospitalized friend he makes an indelible impression on the lives of those around him.
