Come join us in the Children's Room every 3rd week of the month for crafts, design challenges, building challenges, and more. You can come in anytime and do the task, or create something new!



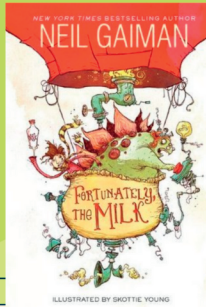
