To be sure, this is a significant amount of preparation, and as hard as we try, there are eleventy-million settings to check and double check. With that much complexity and three libraries, we expect to miss something. But we're trying!

In the meantime, you can prepare yourself by getting used to using our catalog - Catalog Home | Weeks Public Library - so that when the new catalog comes out, the impact will be minimized. In the interest of clarity, it will still be the Weeks Public Library catalog, but the catalog will now search and include items from participating libraries.

Why do I recommend that you use the catalog?

In the new system, you will absolutely be able to drive to any of the participating libraries and get an eligible item using your current library card.

BUT (and this is the biggest benefit of this system!), you'll also be able to put a hold on an item from a participating library from your account in the catalog. Then, twice a week, items from other participating libraries will be delivered/transferred to the "home" library of the patron who put the item on hold. All you need to do is go to your friendly local library and pick up your item(s). Returning items is just as easy - just bring the item(s) back to where you borrowed it and drop it off. We'll take care of the rest, easy-peasy!
